English is the primary language of international medical communication, and pharmacists need good English speaking and listening skills in order to function effectively in any environment where they encounter English-speaking patients and English-speaking medical professionals, whether inside or outside Japan. English Speaking and Listening (ESL) is a course focused on developing these communication skills through active engagement with Internet-based materials covering a wide range of health- and pharmacy-related topics. Classes will be conducted entirely in English so as to maximize exposure to the target language.
